Obtain a Notary Public, who is not interested in the transaction. For example, the notary should not be one of the transferees of the property. 2.

In the presence of the Notary Public, sign the Deed on the line above your printed name(s)on the last page. Sign as your name has been typed, i.e., using the same initials, etc. (This is how the transferor's name appears on the existing land records.) 3.

Date the Deed above your signature(s). 4. \(\subseteq \) Acknowledge to the Notary Public that your signature is your free act and deed, and have the Notary Public: a)

Insert the State, County, and City or Town of acknowledgment. b)

Insert the date of acknowledgment. c) \square Sign his name on the line provided. d) \square Print his name below his signature. e) Impress his seal on the Deed. f) \square Stamp the deed with his ink notarial stamp.
